Late yesterday, March 18th, the American Academy of Ophthalmology announced its determination that in order to mitigate the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) all Ophthalmology practices in the US should immediately cease normal operations. Experience from around the world indicates that ENT and Ophthalmology / Eye Care are particularly high risk specialties for the potential spread of this pandemic viral contagion. In cooperation with all of the unified efforts around this country Eye Care Professionals will no longer be able to see any regularly scheduled patients until further notice. Limited availability for established patients only with truly sight threatening emergencies can be coordinated through our service.
